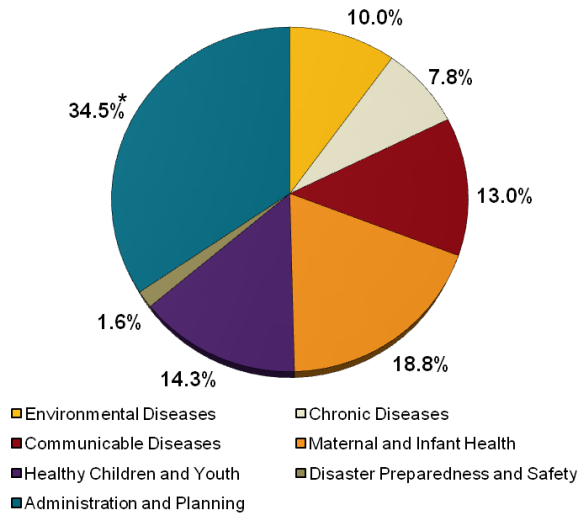

A New District Office

In February 2018, the new District Office opened on the campus of the Florence Government Center. The construction costs were paid in full and came in under budget. This allowed NKY Health to consolidate staff from four different buildings and provide rooms for collaboration, storage and future growth.



WE PREVENT DISEASE by providing community health education, investigating reportable diseases and performing health inspections. This year we:

- Hosted the first local food safety summit to inform food service workers and the general public about safe food handling practices and current food safety issues.
- Prevented the statewide hepatitis A outbreak from reaching NKY for many months.

WE PROMOTE WELLNESS by supporting healthy lifestyles and environments. This year we:

- Partnered with HealthPoint Family Care in Covington and Florence to expand access to WIC programs.
- Supported LiveWell NKY coalitions that created nine marked walking routes, two community gardens, and held 48 exercise and healthy eating events.
- Worked with three school districts and nine schools on their school wellness policies.
- Expanded lead poisoning prevention outreach to pregnant women in Kenton and Campbell Counties.

WE PROTECT AGAINST HEALTH THREATS by continuing to respond to the region's epidemic of heroin and opioid use. This year we:

- Served more than 300 clients and referred 183 clients to treatment through the Grant County Syringe Access Exchange Program.
- Distributed 2,048 naloxone kits to reverse opioid overdoses and prevent premature deaths.
