## JOHNSON & JOHNSON COVID-19 VACCINE\*\*

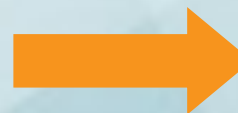
People who are eligible to get a booster shot at least 2 months after their initial dose:

✓ People age 18 and older

\*The Pfizer vaccine is the only approved COVID-19 vaccine that can be given to individuals under the age of 18.

\*\*The CDC now recommends mRNA vaccines (Pfizer and Moderna) as studies have shown mRNA vaccines are more effective at protecting against the Omicron variant.
