Essential functions of the job include, but are not limited to:

2. Develop evaluation plans with appropriate methodologies to strengthen and enhance activities and programs.
3. Build and nurture strategic partnerships to address the needs of populations and improve health outcomes.
4. Incorporate strategies and methods for ethical communication of messages regarding health issues, needs, recommendations, and results.
5. Assist with developing and monitoring budgets, including securing, managing, and leveraging financial resources to assure program sustainability.
6. Utilize public health emergency management principles to prepare for and respond to public health emergencies.
